

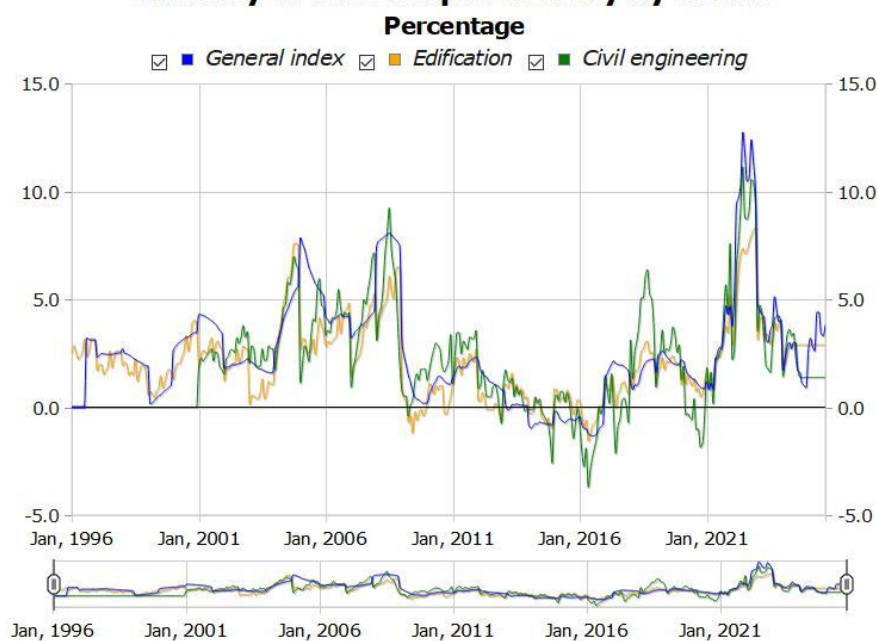
Construction Costs in the Basque Country rose by 0.5% in September 2025

Compared to September 2024, construction costs were up 3.0%

In September 2025, the Construction Costs Index in the Basque Country registered an increase of 0.5% in respect of the previous month, according to Eustat data. In relation to the same month of 2024, costs were up 3.0%.

By sector, in month-on-month terms, costs showed a variation of 0.4% in the Building sector and 0.6% in Civil Engineering. Compared to September 2024, costs increased by 3.0% in the Building sector and 2.9% in Civil Engineering.

With regard to **raw materials**, costs rose by 0.6% in relation to the previous month, while **labour** costs remained constant. In year-on-year terms, the cost of raw materials increased by 4.0% and labour costs were up 0.4%.

In September 2025, costs of raw materials rose by 0.6% compared to August 2025 in the Building sector, and by 0.8% in Civil Engineering. Meanwhile, in the year-on-year evolution, costs of raw materials increased by 4.0% in the Building sector and by 3.8% in Civil Engineering.

In September 2025, there was a widespread rise in the cost of raw materials consumed by the construction sector. The greatest increases compared to the same month of the previous year were seen in *Manufacture of electrical material and equipment*, with a rise of 9.4%, followed by *Manufacture of metal products, except machinery and equipment* and *Extraction industries*, both with a year-on-year increase of 2.0%. The rises in raw material costs were more moderate in *Manufacture of other non-metallic minerals*, with an increase of 1.6%, and *Coke plants and oil refining*, with an increase of 1.7%.
